

Scrap supply conditions for foundry plant.

Extral. ul. Ekonomiczna 1, Rybnik

- **General delivery terms:**

- a) Goods are accepted on working days from **7:00** to **15:00**.
- b) Delivery notification is required no later than **2** days before the planned delivery date to the following address: awizacje.rybnik@extral.com; otherwise, the supplier must take into account the possibility of unloading at a different time.
- c) Please report the risk of delays / changes in deliveries to the address:
awizacje.rybnik@extral.com
- d) The Supplier is obliged to issue a Waste Transfer Note in the BDO system before the delivery of scrap.

- **Specific delivery conditions for aluminum scrap:**

- a) The delivered scrap must be sorted into the appropriate type according to the order.
- b) The supplier is obliged to include the order number on the delivery document and on the invoice.
- c) The basis for settling the delivery is the calibrated Extral weight.
- d) The delivered scrap must not show any traces of radioactivity above the background level of 1 µSV/h and must not, under any circumstances, contain explosive, dangerous or radioactive materials.
- e) Material that does not comply with the quality requirements and/or the order will be reclassified to another assortment or returned.
- f) If it is necessary to segregate scrap, the costs will be charged to the scrap supplier.
- g) In the event of delivery of scrap loaded on a vehicle in a way that unloading carries a high risk of damage to the vehicle, the recipient shall not be liable for any damage caused.

h) The delivered scrap metal must not contain, among others:

- Dust
- Free iron
- Other metals
- Heavy metal contamination
- Explosive and hazardous elements
- Wooden elements
- Other non-metallic contamination, such as paper, plastic, rubber, etc.

i) The delivered scrap should be dry. In case of saturated scrap with large amount of water or other liquids, the percentage of the delivered scrap weight will be deducted.

j) Extral accepts scrap:

- Loose - pieces from 3 cm to 150 cm long.
- Long-loads – **packed in bundles up to 6m long, fastened with tapes in at least 4 places**, with a diameter of about 1m (without paper, foil, cardboard, wood or other impurities). Individual packages must be separated with wooden or aluminum dividers with a thickness of at least 80mm for safe and quick unloading.
- Big-Bags – pieces from 3cm.
- Chips – loose or in big bags with a permissible moisture level of up to 5%.

k) Scrap below 30mm in length will not be accepted. Extral reserves the right to reduce the weight in this respect. (Does not apply to chips and offcuts or other individual arrangements confirmed in the order)

l) Required entries on the delivery document:

- declaration: "The scrap does not contain any explosive, dangerous or radioactive materials"

m) Any deviations from the above guidelines must be reported prior to delivery. If deviations are found at the time of delivery, Extral reserves the right to refuse acceptance.
